- 1 Collection of vegetables (three kinds, two of each)
- 2 Four potatoes (any one variety)
- 3 Three carrots

- 9 Three Onions

CUT FLOWERS

- 11 Dahlias (three blooms)

COOKERY

- 15 Victoria Sandwich (jam filled, no sugar dusting)
- 16 Savoury scones – 4 on a plate

- 18 Man about the house – (1 cake or sponge on a plate) – **men only**
- 19 Fairy cakes – 6 on a plate, to be decorated with an animal theme – **children only**, 2 age ranges 6 and under and 7-11 years

HANDICRAFT

- 20 Hand knitted garment for a child
- 21 Home made cushion
- 22 Cross stitch – 1 article (may be framed)
- 23 Woodwork – 1 item

PHOTOGRAPHY

- 24 Adults – 1 colour or black and white print of a Newbury landmark
- 25 Children – (6 years and under, 7-11 years) “my pet”, colour or black and white

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **Entry Forms** must be submitted to Sue Page, Newbury Town Council, Town Hall, Market Place, Newbury, RG14 5AA by **20th August 2008**. Children may exhibit in all categories but will be judged alongside adult entries with no allowances made. For children only categories please specify the entrant's age.
2. **Exhibiting on the day:** Exhibits must be staged between 9am and 10.30am. Every exhibit must bear a show card, distributed on receipt of entry, or the entry will be marked as invalid. Judging will commence between 11am and 12.30pm during which time the marquee must be vacated.
3. All categories are open to anybody who lives within the Newbury Town Council Parish Boundaries. If unsure of the validity of your address please call 01635 35486 for advice.
4. Exhibitors may only exhibit only one entry per class.
5. All produce exhibited must have been grown in the exhibitor's own garden, allotment or greenhouse. Newbury Town Council reserves the right to apply to view by appointment.
6. No two members from the same household may enter produce from the same garden/allotment/greenhouse in the same class.
7. **Photography:** All photographs should be unframed and mounted on a display card no larger than 10" x 12".
8. Newbury Town Council accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits.
9. All exhibitors are responsible for removing their exhibits from the marquee no later than 6pm, any exhibits left after this time will be disposed of accordingly.
10. Newbury Town Council would appreciate any exhibits to be auctioned in aid of funds. Should you wish your exhibit to be available for sale, please contact Sue Page for an appropriate sticker which must be displayed on the day.
11. The judges' decision is considered to be final. If the exhibits are of insufficient merit then prizes may not be issued.
12. Prizegiving will be within the marquee at 5.30pm.
13. Exhibitors must provide their own vases, plates, etc.
14. Final interpretation of the rules and regulations rests with the Show Committee
15. Any employee or sub contractor of Newbury Town Council is not eligible to enter any of the above categories.
