



FELTRE PLACE NAMED IN HONOUR OF TWIN TOWN

The Newbury Twin Town Association recently invited the Feltre Flag Wavers to Newbury, to perform at the Fringe Festival. They put on a spectacular show, well covered in the local press.

Feltre is Newbury's fourth Twin Town, set in the foothills of the Dolomites in the north-east of Italy. While they were here, the flag wavers were honoured to attend the naming ceremony of Feltre Place, a new development between Newtown Road and Argyle Road just to the south of the town centre.

The town boundary signs were also updated to include Feltre, in time for the visit.
