



Town Hall Refurbishment



Newbury Town Council is carrying out some further refurbishment work on the Town Hall. This listed building is a much loved asset of the town and it needs constant and careful conservation to protect it for the future. Work on re-pointing the lower brickwork is already underway, with careful mixing of the lime based mortar to ensure a good match to the existing pointing.

The next phase, starting on 20 February 2006, will be painting and repair of the Council Chamber window frames. At the same time, building work will be carried out to recreate a storage room at the rear of the Council Chamber. Currently, spare furniture (used to enable the Chamber to be used as a Conference facility) is stored in the Chamber itself. This stage of the work will require scaffolding to be erected on the east side of the Town Hall, to minimize the impact on the interior of the building.
