On Sunday 24 June 2007 at 12.15 pm a dedication of plaques ceremony will take place at Shaw Cemetery. The plaques are to be dedicated to the service of the Burma Star, Royal Berks Comrades, Royal Artillery and Royal Naval Associations. Councillor Adrian Edwards, the Mayor of Newbury, proposes to acknowledge the service given by the members of these organisations to this Country and our town.

On Wednesday 27 June at 11.00 am at the War Memorial in Newbury, there will be a brief service of thanks.

On Sunday 1 July at 12.00 noon a procession of Veterans, led by the Queens Piper, will leave the Wharf, marching along Wharf Street, Mansion House, Street and West Mills to St Nicolas Church. The Mayor of Newbury will take the salute in Wharf Street (in front of NatWest Bank) before joining the Veterans for a church service, together with Newbury Town Councillors and other distinguished guests. After the service the parade will return to the British Legion along Northbrook Street at around 1.15pm.
