In the year ended 31 March 2019 Newbury Town Council received £15,807.95 in CIL receipts from West Berkshire Council.

- £12,790 on gym equipment and surfacing in Blossoms Field
- £4,600 on new play equipment in Victoria Park
- £450 on a replacement basket swing at Christie Heights
- £500 on a replacement basket swing at Digby Road
- £716 on a drinking tap outside the Wharf Toilets
