

With a number of parks in the centre of Newbury and its surrounds, it's easy to get active outdoors in the fresh air. Newbury Town Council's tennis courts at Victoria Park have Lawn Tennis Association standard floodlighting and are now part of the one-stop-shop for playing tennis in Newbury and Thatcham. There are affordable household memberships that make it super easy to pick up a racket and you can 'pay and play' too.
