Newbury Town Council has praised the success of the Newbury Young Traders Market, held on 30 May alongside the regular Saturday market.

Organised in partnership with the National Market Traders Federation, the event showcased a variety of young entrepreneurs selling handmade crafts, artwork, street food and other creative products.

The market attracted strong visitor numbers, with shoppers supporting the next generation of independent businesses. Awards were presented by the Mayor of Newbury, Cllr Jo Day, with Katie Swanson of Katie Daisy Designs named overall winner and progressing to the next stage of the national competition.

All traders received Highly Commended certificates in recognition of their creativity and professionalism.

Council representatives and the National Market Traders Federation praised the event for providing valuable opportunities for young people to gain experience, build confidence and grow their businesses.
