Right to erect a headstone, cross, Monument or any other memorial	£545	£185
Right to place an inscribed vase at the grave head position	£145	£50
Right to place a memorial on a cremated remains plot not exceeding 500mm (1' 8") in height above ground level	£145	£50
Additional inscription	£85	£25

All Memorial fees are inclusive of VAT at the applicable rate Applications for Memorial work must be authorised by the Council

Ancillary Charges

	Our-of-Parish	In-Parish
Transferring deeds of rights of burial	£50	£50

In-Parish charges are appropriate when:

a) the deceased was a resident of the Parish of Newbury at the time of death; or

b) the deceased had resided in the Parish of Newbury in any period of one year or more in the 10 years prior to the time of death; or

c) having been a resident of the Parish of Newbury for a minimum of 5 years, the deceased had been relocated in exceptional circumstances (for example to enable medical care or for military or equivalent service) beyond their reasonable control.

Documented proof of residency and reasoning in support of b) or c) above must be provided.

The final decision to charge the In-Parish rate rests with and is at the discretion of the Council.
